Do You Have to Report to the EPA?

On top of everything else with reporting this year, you must report certain ["chronically leaking appliances"](#) to the EPA no later than **March 1, 2024**. If you don't, nothing will put you on the EPA's radar faster than this.



Washington State Regulations: Are you already in trouble?

[Washington's refrigerant regulations](#) went into effect Jan 1, 2024. Did you have leaks in January? Did you repair them within 14 days? The deadline to register facilities that contain at least one appliance with a full charge of 1500+ lbs. is **March 15, 2024**.



New York State joins the State Regulation Crowd

New York is proposing the most aggressive refrigerant regulations in the country: [refrigerant bans](#) for everything under the sun and a forced transition to 20-year GWPs <10 for [existing systems](#).



The NASRC has money for California Supermarkets

After proving they were great at helping supermarkets take advantage of CA grants, it was a 'no brainer' for CARB to pick the NASRC to administer [\\$65 million to help retailers](#) convert their high GWP systems. Keep an eye out, because it will likely be first come, first served!
